St. Mary's High School was founded in 1920 by the School Sisters of Notre Dame. The first four-year class graduated in 1925. In 1989 an association was formed with surrounding area parishes. The parishes were invited to be contributing members of the newly created Catholic Central High School and offered positions on the CCHS School Board. Currently, there are 16 member parishes and six parish grade schools that comprise Catholic Central.
