Concurrent Enrollment Partnership Cardinal Stritch University and Catholic Central High School

What is a Concurrent Enrollment Program?

Concurrent Enrollment Programs (CEP) allow qualified high school students to learn and qualified high school instructors to teach Cardinal Stritch University's curriculum at the high school's campus during the high school's regular hours while concurrently earning high school and college credit. Concurrent enrollment programs are growing nationwide. Sixty-four percent of postsecondary institutions had concurrent enrollment programs offering courses at high school campuses in 2010-12; only 55% did so in 2002-03 (NCES, 2013). The National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships (NACEP) and partner organizations are working to expand concurrent enrollment opportunities.

CEP Partnership between Cardinal Stritch University and Catholic Central High School

For the 2018-19 school year, qualified Catholic Central students are eligible to concurrently enroll in the following classes for both college credits and high school credits:

Admission/Registration process and College Transcript

Qualified Catholic Central students who choose to enroll in one of these courses for college credits from Cardinal Stritch University are admitted to the University as "non-degree seeking students." Upon successful completion (minimum grade of 'C'), these students will receive three or four college credits and an official Cardinal Stritch University transcript. The official University transcript verifies to other colleges/universities that the student has earned college/university credits.

Cost

The cost is \$133 per credit (\$399 for a 3-credit course). The 2018-19 regular Undergraduate tuition rate is \$973 per credit (\$2,919 for a 3-credit course). This is roughly an 87% discount rate.

Online Registration for Concurrent Enrollment Courses

Concurrent Enrollment allows you to earn credit for the course at your high school as well as college credit through Stritch. Concurrent Enrollment courses cost \$133 per credit, so a typical 3-credit course costs \$399. If you are interested in registering for a course for concurrent credit, please follow the steps below. **Registration for 2018-19 CEP Courses is due August 1st. Payment is due September 1st.**

1. Students/parents can complete the online registration by going to the following link:
www.stritch.edu/hsce
 - Select your High School
 - Select the year (2018 for Fall and full year courses, 2019 for Spring Courses)
 - Select the term (Fall, Spring, or full year)
 - If you do not see the course you are looking for, change the term you selected.
 - Click the box next to each course you would like to take for college credit
(remember, you must be registered for the course at your high school to qualify)
 - Complete the “Your Information” section
 - Click the box next to “I understand that by submitting this completed application I am enrolling in a Concurrent Enrollment (CE) course at Cardinal Stritch University and will be charged tuition for each CE course I enroll in.”
 - Type your first and last name under Student Signature and type the date in the format indicated.
 - Click Submit
2. Once the online application is complete, you will receive log-in information regarding Stritch’s intranet (my.stritch.edu), which houses account information and access to payment options, including online payment. Please watch your e-mail for this information.
 - *Keep in mind that only fall and full year courses are billed this summer/fall. Spring courses will be billed around December 1st. If you signed up for a spring course, you will receive communication in December regarding payment.*
