

# Catholic Central Hot Lunch

## eFunds Quick Reference for 2022-23

1. Our Hot Lunch Program uses a scanner system to charge students for hot lunch options: main entree, pre-made salad, or ala carte milk consumed each day. Your student's ID card is scanned at the beginning of the lunch line.

As with any business, the logistics of this system are much easier when your student's lunch account is maintained with a positive monetary balance.

The eFunds system provides you the convenience of funding your student's account at home on-line. To eliminate the need to send cash/checks to school which can be misplaced or lost, we ask that you please utilize the eFunds system that is set up for our school. **Exceptions must be requested through the school office.**

2. Freshman students or transfer students will be mailed information regarding the setup of an eFunds account with a unique ID number. If your freshman student attended Burlington Catholic School, the account is already set up and will be rolled over as a Catholic Central account.
3. Once you have set up your student's eFunds account, the **most efficient method to maintain a positive monetary balance is to set up an automatic replenishment when a lunch account balance reaches a designated threshold.**

You can also be alerted through eFunds when your student's account reaches a certain threshold, for instance \$15 or \$10. At that time, money **should be immediately deposited to maintain a positive balance.**

\*\* If your student loses or damages his or her ID card, another ID card must be purchased for \$5 at the school office.
