

# THE VALUE OF VIRTUES

What does it mean to be a Hilltopper? Our graduates are formed in **Faith**, armed with rigorous, academic **Knowledge**, and steeped in a 100 year old **Tradition** of excellence. We understand the financial investment a family needs to consider when contemplating a Catholic Central education. Our donors and benefactors generously contribute their support, keeping our tuition affordable with a great return on investment for families including college scholarships and college academic credit.

# **TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS**

Here are just a few of the tuition assistance programs available to our families:



Partner Parish Discount: All families that are members of one of our 16 partner parishes receive a tuition discount from the school (You may also reach out to your local parish for other financial savings opportunities.)

Rewald Scholarship Trust: This fund was created by Mr. Rewald, a business owner in the local area, to help families pay for CC.

Mary Alice Yakich Foundation: This fund exists to provide opportunities for students who are in need of financial support to attend high quality schools.

The Wisconsin and Racine Parental Choice Program: Families who qualify for this program receive a 100% tuition discount to attend Catholic Central High School.

> Nearly \$500,000 in financial aid was awarded amongst families in 2024. The average outof-pocket cost for families seeking tuition assistance is approximately \$3,500 per year (or \$300 per month).

# **100%** of families

who applied for financial aid in the 2024-25 school year received some form of need-based assistance.

**\$15,000** per year, on average, is raised towards tuition through our "Scrip" program.

# AN INVESTMENT FOR A LIFETIME OF REWARD

Catholic Central students are prepared for whatever life path they choose. For most of our graduates this path includes college, with some students opting for trade schools or the military. We take great pride in preparing our students for future academic success. 56% of CC students took an AP class last school year, and out of the 56%, multiple examinees were named AP Scholars or AP Scholars with Honors. CC students had a 100% pass rate for the following exams: AP Biology, AP English Language & Composition and AP Literature & Composition.





# Our graduates are accepted to some of the finest colleges, universities and military programs in the country.

Here is just a sample of where our students have enrolled after graduation in the last few years: Duke, Notre Dame, University of Boston, Stanford, Miami of Ohio, Georgetown, Loyola, Amherst, St. Olaf, Boston College, Naval Nuclear Submarine Program, and U.S. Military Academy at West Point.

\$29,000 is the average college scholarship accepted by a CC graduate last year.

The graduating Class of 2024 (38 students) was offered \$2.8 million and accepted \$1.1 million.



# **COLLEGE GRADUATION RATES MATTER**

With Catholic Central High School's robust Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment course offerings, our graduates are able to transfer academic credit to the colleges they attend that will satisfy both General Education and major-specific requirements. Trained by the rigor of these courses to meet the demands of a collegiate curriculum, they often graduate on time or early. Combined with the merit-based scholarships they receive from colleges and community-based organizations, a college degree becomes much more affordable for many of our families.

This is in stark contrast to public schools, where 40% of the students require remedial courses in mathematics and reading to enter college, and achieve only a 49% graduation rate in four years.
